Event Overview & Emergency Action Plan Overview

This is an ABBREVIATED Emergency Action Plan Overview for the 2019 Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg (the “Event”) and is to be used in conjunction with the City of St. Petersburg and INDYCAR emergency plans. The Event is owned and operated by Green Savoree St. Petersburg, LLC (“GSSP”), will be held from March 8-10, 2019. The sport of automobile racing is an inherently dangerous activity and involves a certain amount of risk. There are also non-racing emergency situations that could arise due to natural disasters or incidents which occur apart from race-related activities.

EVENT CONTROL:

GSSP manages onsite Event operations through a command center known as “Event Control” located on the 2nd floor of the Mahaffey Theater. Every GSSP-issued event radio will have access to a “Base” dispatcher, Channel #1. Note: your Team Leader will have the EVENT CONTROL telephone number, which is NON-PUBLISHED and should not be distributed or made public.

SPECTATOR MEDICAL STATIONS:

There are four (4) Spectator Care locations on site which are staffed by Bayfront Health St. Petersburg staff. See your map for exact locations.

EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

A key principle for properly responding to any emergency situation is to always remain calm and handle oneself in a professional manner. An emergency situation occurs when an incident does or may result in injury to a participant, patron or staff member.

EMERGENCY ACTION PROCEDURES:

Initial Steps:

- Stay calm, Keep safe.
- *Advise your Team Leader and/or Event Control by Radio:* Channel One (#1) – advise “Base” operator your name, location and nature of the incident, then await further instruction from Base operator
- If communication with your Team Leader or Event Control is not possible, *locate police or fire rescue personnel in your area. As last resort, dial 911.*

For purpose of this Plan, Emergency situations have been categorized into the following three classifications:

SPECIFIC EMERGENCY SITUATIONS:

A. *Lost/Found Person*

If you are notified of a Lost Person:

1. Notify your Team Leader or Event Control immediately to have security personnel dispatched.
2. If possible, keep the individual attempting to find the lost person with you. Do not remove this individual from the location where the lost person was last seen.



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If you are notified of a Found Person:

Notify your Team Leader or Event Control immediately to have security personnel dispatched.

B. Injuries/Accidents

1. Notify your Team Leader and/or Event Control immediately.
2. State how many persons and the nature and type of the incident. Trained medical personnel are not far away from any spot on the venue.

While waiting for First Aid to arrive:

1. Be calm, take command, and enlist the help of others, if necessary.
2. Keep the immediate area clear.
3. Keep injured person(s) lying down and quiet.
4. Reassure and comfort person(s).
5. Send someone to guide the medical team to your location.

First Aid should never be attempted except under extraordinary circumstances.

C. Mass Casualties/Evacuation

In the unlikely event of an incident involving mass casualties and/or the need for evacuation, City of St. Pete's police and/or fire rescue will take over the situation and provide direction. You are not asked to put yourself in any peril whatsoever in these situations to the extent you are no longer able to assist guest, especially in the event of an evacuation. Video board messages will be displayed to assist with guests, including the hearing-impaired.

POLICY REGARDING CONTACT WITH MEDIA

The Event Media Operations Director and/or GSSP ownership are the *only persons authorized to communicate with the media* about matters involving the Event not otherwise controlled by a local government agency. Refer all media personnel politely but firmly to the authorized staff. Do not offer information or respond to questions.

NOTES:

1. Always carry a copy of this plan and a map of the race area
2. Know your chain of command and defer to uniformed personnel during an incident response
3. Know the route to safety for you and your entire area of responsibility
4. Know how to notify your supervisors and where your supervisors are located
5. Carry a pen/pencil and paper to write down important notes
6. Practice assertive hospitality to all guests - be proactive in your job responsibilities - know your limits
7. Wear ear protection and the proper clothing

Any questions or comments should be directed to supervising GSSP Staff member or Event Control. Inspect your assigned work area and immediately report to a supervisor any dangerous situations, activities, materials, equipment or any other item that seems likely to cause harm.

2019 Track Crossings - Policies & Procedures

Track Crossing Locations:

There are three locations for ground-level track crossings: the Chevrolet bridge @ Turn 2, the Firestone bridge @ Turn 6/7 and the Yacht Club bridge @ Turn 11. Handicap patrons waiting for the Chevrolet bridge track crossing will be directed to Grandstand 10 where they can wait for track clearance (must have a grandstand ticket in another grandstand). Handicap patrons at the Firestone bridge track crossing must wait for track clearance or be directed to the 5th Avenue Spectator Gate. Track crossing @ the Yacht Club bridge will be available as needed.

Opening of Track Crossing Protocols:

The process for opening the Track Crossings is as follows:

- 1) Race Control advises Event Control the track is cold and track crossings may be opened
- 2) Event Control directs Private Security and Access Control Volunteers that track crossings are now opened
- 3) Access Control Volunteers unlock and open the appropriate gates, allowing spectators to cross the track
- 4) Private Security and Access Control Volunteers escort spectators safely across the track, while looking both directions on the track.

Closure of Track Crossing Protocols:

The process for closing the Track Crossings is as follows:

- 1) At the appropriate time in the Minute-x-Minute Schedule or upon instruction from Race Control, Event Control directs Private Security and Access Control Volunteers that track crossings are now closed.
 - 2) Private Security and Access Control Volunteers escort remaining spectators off the track and return to post. Access Control Volunteers lock the gates.
 - 3) Both Private Security and Access Control Volunteers report to Event Control that "track crossings are closed".
 - 4) *** Upon confirmation from both Private Security and Access Control Volunteers, Event Control advises Race Control "track crossings are closed." ***
 - 5) Upon confirmation from Event Control, Race Control resumes on-track activity.
- *** Event Control considers that track crossings to be OPEN until BOTH Private Security and Access Control Volunteers confirm they are CLOSED. ***
